The lecture will deal with architectural and conceptual gestures of turning inside/out spatial volumes and of relating to the increasing indistinction of work and leisure in today's flexible capitalism. I will touch upon notions and practices of cultural garbology, re-evaluated everydayness and small-scale urbanism.
